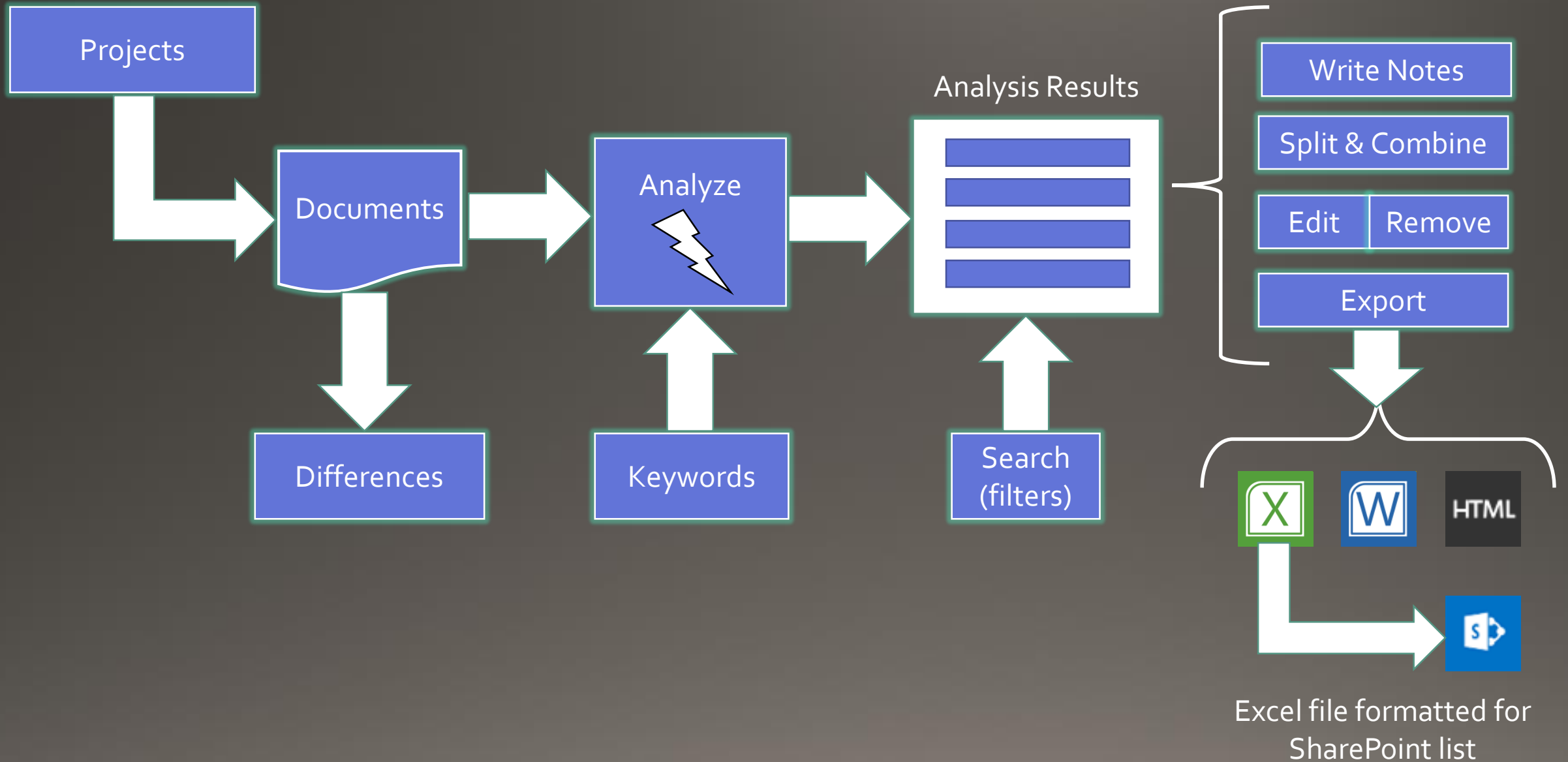

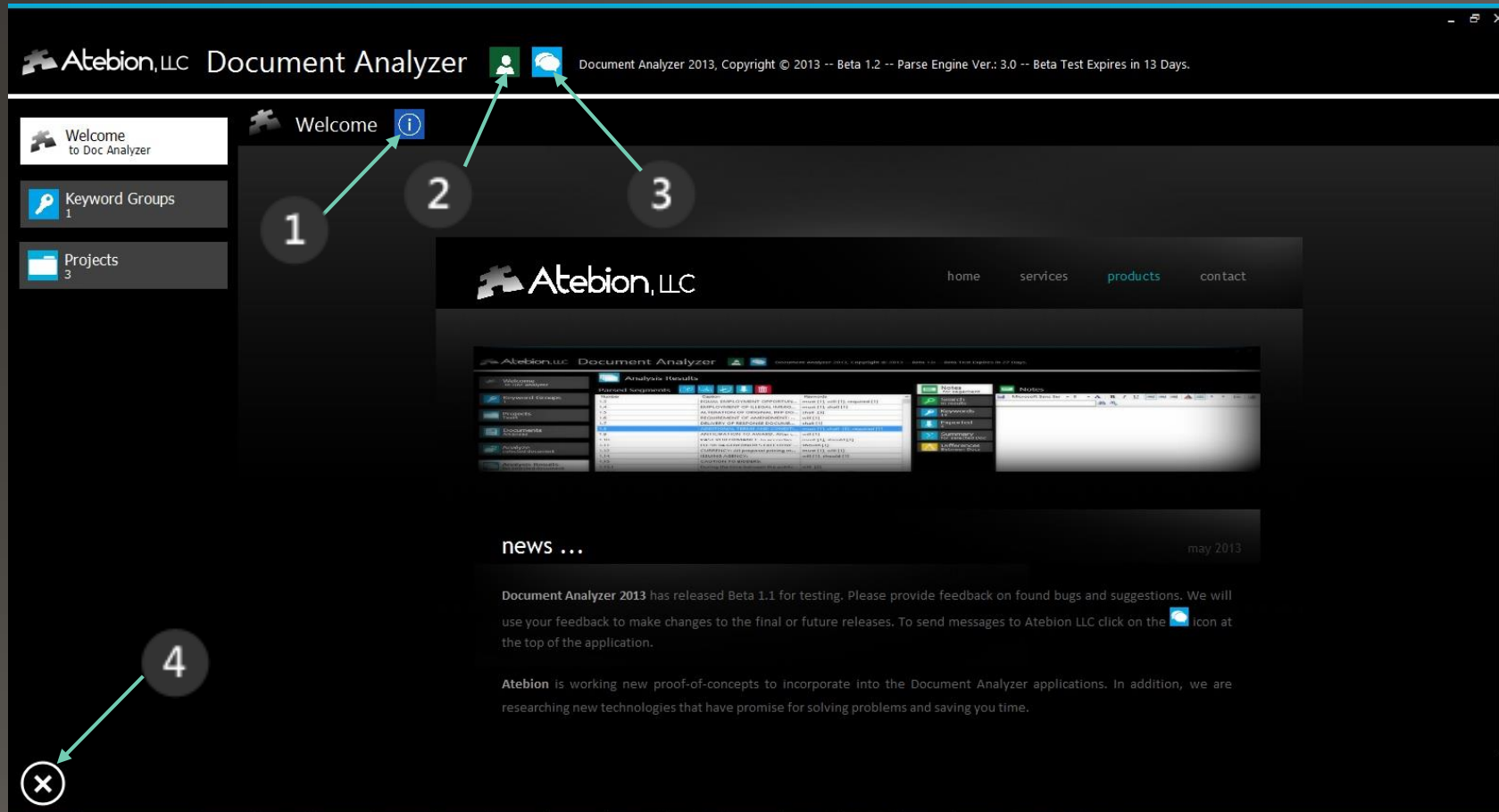

Projects

A **Project** groups associated documents and their analysis results.

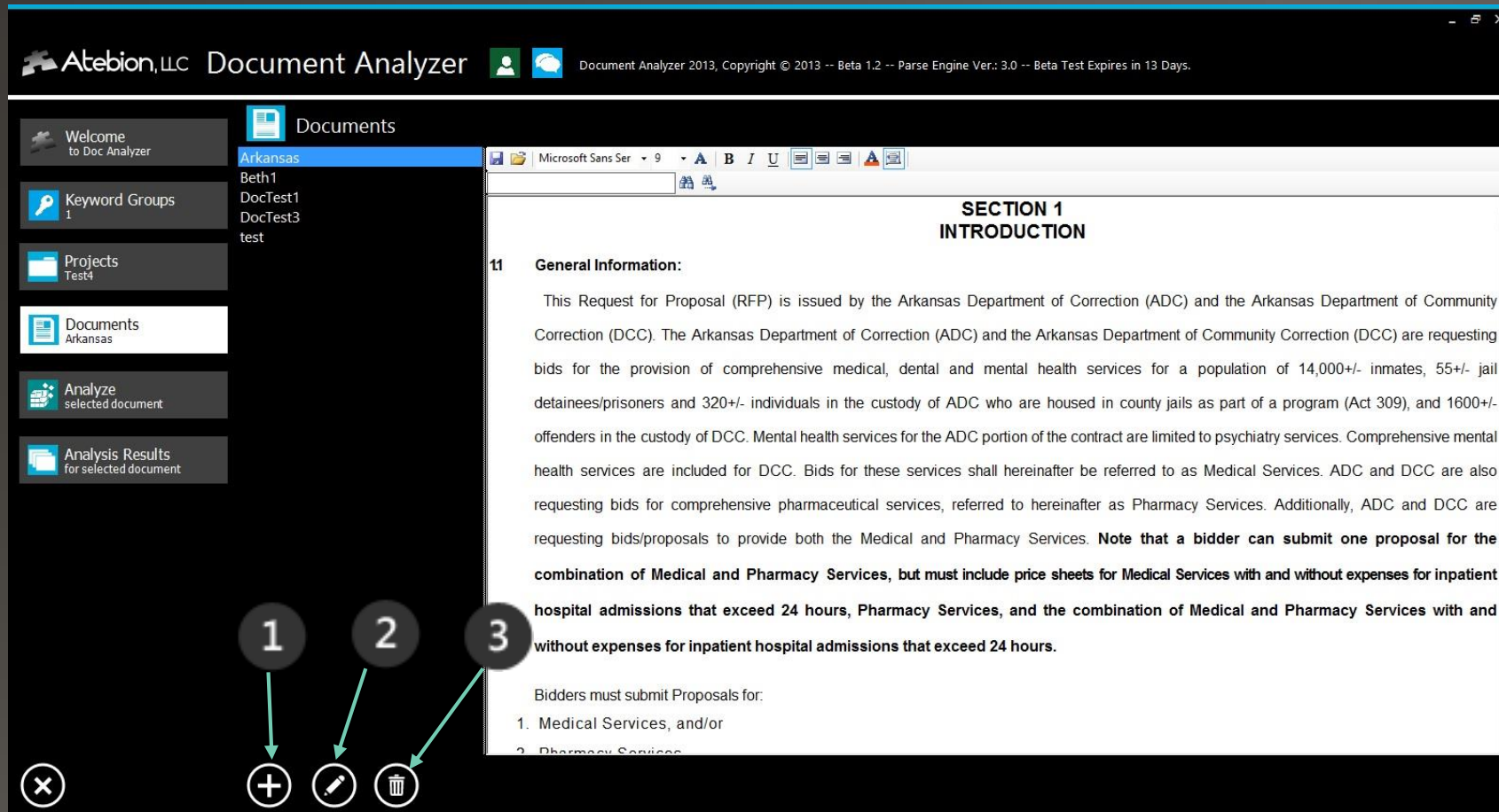
For example, you may be a lawyer, and as such you can create a Project to hold your client's contracts and related analysis results. Another example, as a Proposal Manager you create a project for a specified proposal.

Documents

The Documents panel holds a list of documents for a selected Project.



1 Adds a new Document – The application can import file types: doc, docx, rtf, and pdf. MS Word is required for Doc and Docx. Then the application converts the selected file into a rtf (rich text format) file. Therefore if you have trouble importing a file, try to convert it to the rtf file type outside of this application.

2 Replace the selected Document – Whenever you replace a document, the application shows the differences between the new document and the previous version.

3 Remove the selected Document – Documents are not actually deleted, but are prefixed with ~, which is filtered-out from the Documents list.

Analyze

The Document Analyzer parses (strips) legal type documents into segments based on a document's numeration (e.g., I, II, III, 1., 2., 3. A, B, C. ...) and then locates Keywords within each parsed segment.

Analyze

After you click the Analyze Run button, the Document Analyzer parses (strips) the selected document into segments. Typically this analysis process takes less than one minute, while large documents may require more time.

Analysis Results – search

The **Search** feature searches the parsed results and then filters the parse results list per the search results. In addition, you can export the search filtered results.
